Assigned learning

Learning Status

Due:

Appears when a learning activity has been assigned to you, and includes the due date.

Ready to Document:

Appears when you have successfully completed a learning activity. From here, you can Record Completion of the learning.

MY TEAM

To notify your manager that you have completed the activity, you must Record Completion.

Completed:

Appears when you have completed the full CPD documentation process.

Overdue:

Appears if you do not complete the assigned learning by the due date.



If you do not complete the assigned learning within the due or overdue period set by your Organisation Manager, you will lose access to it.
